Cannabis Licensing Annual Report for the period April 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023

Licensing Activities pursuant to Section 21 (2) of the *Cannabis Act*:

One retail license for remote sales and an enclosed store to operate in Iqaluit, Nunavut, was issued for the period from April 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023.

One retail licence for a remote sales store to operate from Rankin Inlet, Nunavut, was issued for the period of January 17, 2023 to March 31, 2023.

One application was received on April 4, 2022 for an enclosed store to operate in Iqaluit, Nunavut. No licence has been issued yet.

One application was received on October 6, 2022 for a remote sales store to operate from Leamington, Ontario. No licence has been issued yet.

Licensing Activities pursuant to Section 14 (1) and (3) of the *Cannabis Act*:

On September 1, 2022 a new retail licence was issued for the retailer located in Iqaluit, to include a licence variation for a change of hours of operations.
