



## Invitation for Applications Chief Electoral Officer

The Legislative Assembly of Nunavut's Management and Services Board invites applications for the unique and challenging position of Chief Electoral Officer of Nunavut. The Chief Electoral Officer is an independent officer of the Legislative Assembly. This is a seven-year statutory appointment. The Chief Electoral Officer is appointed by the Commissioner of Nunavut on the recommendation of the Legislative Assembly.

The Chief Electoral Officer is accountable for the administration of all territorial general elections and by-elections under the *Nunavut Elections Act*, plebiscites under the *Plebiscites Act* and local option votes under the *Liquor Act*. Recent amendments to the *Nunavut Elections Act* and the *Legislative Assembly and Executive Council Act* provide that territorial general elections will be held every four years. Consequently, the next territorial general election is scheduled to take place on October 30, 2017. The successful candidate will be an experienced senior manager with proven professional success in managing complex administrative operations. Knowledge of electoral administration is essential. This position requires a high degree of attention to detail, including the ability to accurately interpret, administer and explain complex statutes and regulations. The successful candidate will possess the ability to communicate clearly and consistently with the general public, stakeholder groups and the news media. Excellent writing skills, including the ability to draft comprehensive annual reports to the Legislative Assembly, are required. Understanding of Inuit societal values, language and culture is a definite asset.
