Dear Mme Emmanuelle Sajous,

**RE: Request to have a Diamond Jubilee Medal revoked**

I am writing to request that the Diamond Jubilee Medal awarded to Mr. Ike Haulli of Igloodik, Nunavut be revoked. In addition to his 2008 conviction for indecent assault, Mr. Haulli recently lost a civil suit and must pay damages to a number of young victims that he sexually abused between 1968 and 1986. His conduct has had a devastating impact on a number of lives and has made him unfit for such an honour.

My request comes with the support of a number of groups within Nunavut, including the Qullit Nunavut Status of Women Council, who noted that "Haulli's violent, predatory and calculated behaviour was heinous."

I stand with the Qullit Nunavut Status of Women council members and ask that the Diamond Jubilee Medal be revoked from Mr. Haulli. I hope that you will seriously consider this request and take the necessary steps to revoke the honour that was conferred on a most undeserving recipient.
