Title: Government of Nunavut Expenditures on Overtime Pay

Expressing the information in a comparable format to that which was provided in Returns to Written Questions 7-4(2) and 15-4(3), what were the Government of Nunavut's expenditures on overtime pay for indeterminate, term, casual and relief employees during the 2016-2017 fiscal year for each of its departments, Crown agencies and territorial corporations?
- 2. Broken down by employing entity (department, Crown agency and territorial corporation) and employment status (indeterminate, term, casual and relief), how many employees received between \$0.01 and \$25,000.00 in overtime pay during the 2016-2017 fiscal year?
- 3. Broken down by employing entity (department, Crown agency and territorial corporation) and employment status (indeterminate, term, casual and relief), how many employees received between \$25,000.01 and \$50,000.00 in overtime pay during the 2016-2017 fiscal year?
- 4. Broken down by employing entity (department, Crown agency and territorial corporation) and employment status (indeterminate, term, casual and relief), how many employees received between \$50,000.01 and \$99,999.99 in overtime pay during the 2016-2017 fiscal year?

- 5. Broken down by employing entity (department, Crown agency and territorial corporation) and employment status (indeterminate, term, casual and relief), how many employees received in excess of \$100,000.00 in overtime pay during the 2016-2017 fiscal year?
- 6. What specific audit activities are undertaken by the Department of Finance in relation to departments, Crown agencies and territorial corporations that incur annual overtime costs in excess of \$1,000,000.00?
